

REACHING LJUBLJANA BY TRAIN

Ljubljana has good international rail connections, almost the entire fleet of trains operated by the Slovenske železnice national railway company was modernised a few years ago.

There are regular train connections to countries around Europe including, among others, the following:

- **Germany** (via Munich)
- **Switzerland** (via Zurich)
- **Austria** (via Salzburg, Villach and Graz)
- **Croatia** (via Zagreb and Rijeka)
- **Hungary** (via Budapest)
- **Czech Republic** (via Prague)
- **Italy** (via Trieste and Venice)
- **Greece, Macedonia and Serbia** (via Salonica, Skopje and Belgrade)
